


# Funding Opportunities

- Wildfire Prevention Grants Program (CalFire)
- Regional Forest & Fire Capacity Program (DOC)
- Climate Ready Program (State Coastal Conservancy)
- Healthy Soils Program (CDFA)
- Prop 4 wildfire chapter funds
- Other internal options (*aspirational*)
  - Budget Change Proposal for grant program to cover prescribed grazing management plan development
  - Direct allocation for regional demonstration site(s)
