









PROBLEMS ASSOCIATED WITH UNMANAGED VEGETATION









Complexity of Fuel Hazard Reduction in Linear RW












Webinar Goal

- All listed items must have a selection (select "N/A" if not applicable).
- ▼ Work description within State highway right-of-way must be comprehensive.
- Does the scope of work involve the use of pesticides (herbicides, insecticides, rodenticides, etc.)?
 - The "Standard Encroachment Permit Application" (form TR-0100) must be signed by the applicant/project or property owner or organization. If signed by an agent, attach a letter of authorization. Note: Box 28 is the applicant's information and box 29 is the authorized agent's.
- Signatures are required on both the application and the letter of authorization.

 Routes connect to County-identified roads and serve as **primary evacuation routes** in the event of a disaster






