



## SALINAS RIVER VEGETATION MANAGEMENT PROJECT

#### HOMELESS POPULATION


150-300 Encampments



2021 - 245,040 pounds removed = \$98,424





#### RIVER FIRE 2020




#### PERMITTING

- Lake and Streambed Alteration Agreement (LSAA) California Department of Fish and Wildlife

# ACCOMPLISHMENTS AND CURRENT STATUS

- Initial entry with mechanized equipment, approximately 85 acres treated 2019
- Expanded the primary firebreaks, and grazed 15 acres as a polit program 2020
- Project approved by RWQCB spring 2021
- Approximately 80 acres grazed, and 25 acres of crew work completed in; approximately fire acres burned within the river 2021
- LSAA approved by CDFW 2022
- Approximately 100 acres grazed, and 20 acres of crew work completed; less than five acres burned within river 2022
