Summary: Bridgeville is the hub for the rural ranching community that surrounds the town. It is on the 2001 Federal Register as a “Community at Risk” and identified for treatment in the Humboldt County Community Wildfire Protection Plan. The key infrastructure in the town includes both a CAL FIRE station and volunteer fire Station, a school, a post office, a church, a communications vault, a CALTRANS yard, and a PG&E substation. The project will extend defensible space around key community structures by removing fuels through mastication, chipping, and/or lop and scatter techniques. Most of the hazardous fuels are thick accumulations of brush and grass.
