
Located just north of the City of Santa Barbara.

Summary: The Santa Barbara Foothill Community Defensible Space Project is critical due to its unique combination of fuel, topography and unique weather patterns. The project area was affected by the Tea, Jesusita, Zaca and Thomas Fires. 80 homes were lost during the Jesusita Fire. The maintenance of roadsides and fuel breaks, identified in the Mission Canyon Community Wildfire Protection Plan and CALMapper, are designed to improve access, escape routes, and community defensible space.


