USE

CAL FIRE's Emergency Crew Transport, or ECT, is designed to transport a 17-person fire crew. The ECT is equipped with emergency warning lights and sirens to allow firefighters to move quickly and safely through congested areas, shortening response times. The new generation ECT is designed with ample storage space for all equipment needed by the fire crew. In addition to fire tools, sleeping bags, and personal protective equipment, the ECT also carries rations, water, and firefighter's personal affects. The vehicle carries everything the crew will need to be self-sufficient for at least 48 hours.
