CAL FIRE's Emergency Crew Transport (ECT) is designed to carry a 17-person fire crew. It has emergency lights and sirens to help firefighters move quickly and safely through busy areas, reducing response times.

The latest ECT model offers plenty of storage for all the crew's equipment, including fire tools, sleeping bags, protective gear, rations, water, and personal items. The vehicle is equipped to keep the crew self-sufficient for at least 48 hours.
