


JOBS IN THE FOREST: HYDROLOGIST

Hydrology – the study of water. A person who studies anything water related (rain, rivers, runoff etc.) and its processes is a hydrologist.

The Water Cycle



Precipitation – rain or snow

Evaporation – water vapor returning to the atmosphere because of heat

Interception – precipitation falling on plants instead of the ground

Throughfall – precipitation that falls through plants and hits the ground

Transpiration – water moves through the tree from the ground to its branches. Once on the branches it returns to the atmosphere

Infiltration – water entering the ground

Subsurface flow – picture underground rivers

Surface flow – rivers, streams and creeks

Groundwater – water stored underground
