Fire Control 3: Structural Fire Fighting (2018) - Amend Maximum Class Size and Instructor/Student Ratios

Recommended Actions:

Approval of amending the maximum class size and instructor/student ratio for Fire Control 3: Structural Fire Fighting (2018).

Background Information:

To align with increased student enrollment numbers, it is the recommendation of SFT that the maximum class size and instructor/student ratios be aligned with enrollment needs.

Analysis/Summary of Issue:

To simplify and align the course scheduling and delivery processes, SFT recommends amending the course's maximum class size to 30 students, amending the instructor/student lecture ratio to 1 Primary Instructor for 30 students, and amending the instructor/student demonstration ratio to 2 Primary Instructors for 30 students.

The Fire Control 3: Structural Fire Fighting (2018) course is requested and processed by SFT approximately 110 times yearly. Nearly 25% of these classes are issued a variance to increase their maximum class size in compliance with 19 CCR § 1980.06 - Petition for Alternative Application to Methods and Procedures. The current maximum class size is 25 students. The amendments above do not affect the instructor/student activities/skills ratios for live fire training; therefore, the change will not increase the risk to student safety or reduce the quality of training.
