#### **Background Information:**

State Fire Training (SFT) manages the curriculum and provides course completion diplomas for 162 courses. SFT identified the discrepancies between the SFT website, Procedures Manual, and the Course Information and Required Materials Manual (CIRM). Several courses are now retired or have not been delivered since 2015. This proposal includes updates, retirements, and new recommendations from the Steering Committee to update and adopt select NWCG Courses.

After that date a new instructor must complete the FEMA-NIMS course or apply for a PACE II review of their instructor qualifications, including appropriate education and practical experience relating to course content.
