Skills Coach Recommended Ratios

Background Information:

The new Skills Coach position is to assist the Registered Primary Instructor with the Psychomotor skills practice within a CFSTES or FSTEP course. This is a separate classification from Registered Psychomotor Skills Evaluator. The FSTEP or CFSTES course plan will indicate if a skills coach can be used for a course delivery. Additionally, the course plan will indicate the Student to Skills Coach ratio and/or the registered instructor/fire fighter instructor to skills coach ratio.

Analysis/Summary of Issue:

In 2019, SFT proposed the implementation of Skills Coach in three phases. These recommendations have been reviewed by the Steering Committee. The Skills Coach is in addition to the required Registered Instructors and to support curriculum delivery. Skills Coaches are optional, and not a required member of the cadre.

It shall be noted on each Course Plan that a Skills Coach cannot <u>oversee or supervise</u> students during high risk operations. This includes but is not limited to open trench operations, high angle or rope rescue operations, live fire operations, or swift water rescue.
