2021 California NFIRS Reporting

Please continue sending your 2020 NFIRS files to CalStats@fire.ca.gov

CalStats is still importing 2020 data. Quarter 4 files that have already been received will be validated and a response will be sent once the file has been imported.

Please send all remaining 2020 files in by March 31st, 2021.

No need to resend your 2020 Q4 files if you have done so already.

eNFIRS Users - Formerly Data Entry Tool (DET) Users

- Users who still have access to the NFIRS 5.0 DET should export and send all remaining 2020 data to CalStats@fire.ca.gov.
- Previous DET users who have not already registered for eNFIRS should go to https://www.nfirs.fema.gov/NFIRSWeb/login and click on "Register as a State & Local User."
- Once the account is approved, users can begin entering 2021 incidents in eNFIRS. Incidents are due on a quarterly basis.
- Moving forward for 2021, eNFIRS users will no longer export files and email them to CalStats.
- Users can reset their own passwords through eNFIRS.

Third-Party Vendor Software Users

Vendor software users will continue to send files to CalStats@fire.ca.gov at the end of each quarter. The NFIRS File Validation Utility tool (VVT) can no longer be used to pre-validate quarterly files exported from vendor software programs. Please send incident files directly to us. The files will be validated, and a response will be sent upon import to the national database.

Third-party vendor software users will not use eNFIRS and should not be registering for an eNFIRS account.
