# NFIRS Coding: Aid Given or Received

**Please do not resend your files.**

## Aid Given or Received Coding

Two conditions must be true in order for a fire department to code an incident report as aid given or received:

1. The aid involved another fire department.
2. Both fire departments arrived on scene of the incident.

If you enter data into a module, you must complete the required fields within that module and any other newly required data. For instance, adding Wildland Module information will make the Controlled Date and Time required in the Basic Module.
