# 2022 NFIRS Incident Validation

## Complete and Import Your NFIRS Reports

## Check the results to make sure your incidents are valid and successfully uploaded.

1. Receive and open the import response email from [NFIRSBulkImport@dhs.gov](mailto:NFIRSBulkImport@dhs.gov).
2. Click on the link to download your **.zip file** containing the results.
3. Locate the **.log file** and open it, scroll to the bottom and check the **summary**.
4. Confirm that your incidents have **imported** and are **valid**.
5. If there are any **import failures** or **invalid incidents** (critical errors), use the [eNFIRS Import and Validation Instructions](#) to find and fix your incidents in your software.
6. Export your **corrected** file from your software and import it to **eNFIRS**.
