# Frequently Asked Questions



## How often are fire departments required to report incidents to NFIRS?

Answer: Incidents are due monthly by the 15th of the following month.

#### Can a fire department import multiple months in one file?

Answer: Yes. You can also import three individual files or three .zip files containing up to 10 .txt files at a time.

## I tried logging into my eNFIRS account and received a message indicating that my account was locked. What do I do?

Answer: Click on "Forgot Password" and follow the prompts. Make sure you are not using autofill or copy/paste to add your temporary password or previous password during the password update process.
