



Office of the State Fire Marshal National Fire Incident Reporting System California State-Level Plus-One Codes

Background: Every coded National Fire Incident Reporting System (NFIRS) field allows for one additional level of specificity, definable by the state. For example, if the national standard for a code is three digits, a fourth digit is allowed for the states to provide more specific responses. This additional digit can be alphabetical or numerical.

The Office of the State Fire Marshal (OSFM) has decided to use this option to add several choices in NFIRS to identify various scenarios that are not specified at the national level. Below is a list of all state-level plus-one codes for California.

Note: Use of these plus-one codes is not required. It is an option for California fire departments that would like a standardized way to document these types of incidents at the local and state level.
