

Honeywell Recalls System Sensor L-Series Low Frequency Fire Alarm Sounders and Strobes





On March 14, 2024, Honeywell and System Sensor recalled System Sensor L-series Low Frequency Sounders and Strobes for residential apartments and commercial buildings because the sounders and strobes can malfunction and cause the fire alarm system to fail to alert consumers of a fire.

The model number, date codes and "System Sensor" are printed on the product label and carton. Date codes 3034 and 3035 and the following models are included in this recall:
