ONBOARDING PROGRESS - MILESTONES TO NOVEMBER

JAN 2025 – System Launch

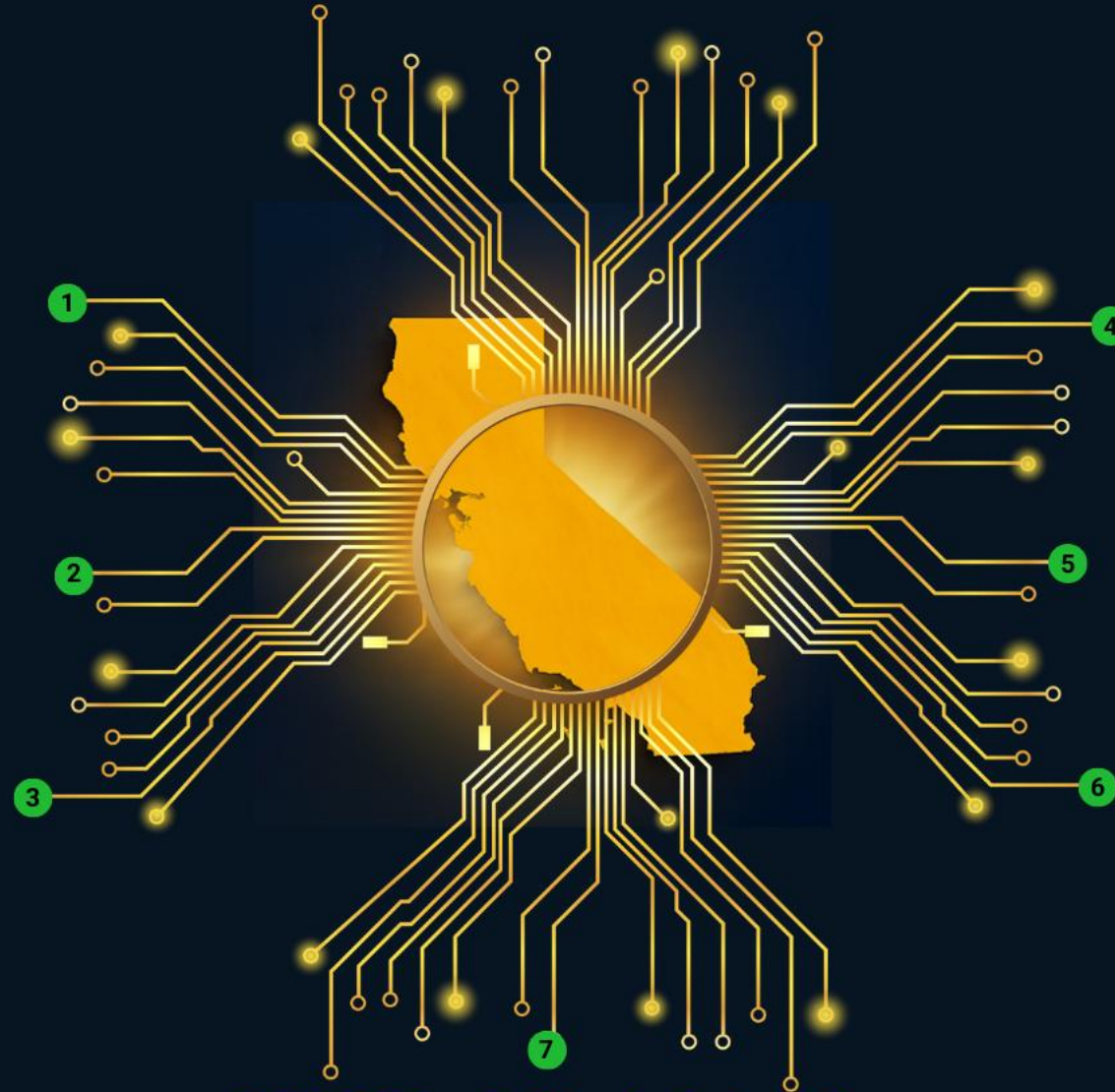
- NERIS goes live.
- First department (South Dakota) submits incidents on January 2.

FEB 2025 – Vendor Integration

- First RMS vendors earn NERIS Version 1 compatibility badges.
- Opens the door for connected data transfers.

APR 2025 – First RMS Data Flow

- First RMS-connected department (Virginia metro) submits incidents via API.



MAY 2025 – Region 2 Onboarding

- New York & New Jersey lead FEMA Region 2 onboarding.
- 1,800+ departments onboarded in a single day.

JUN 2025 – Region 4 Onboarding

- Additional FEMA region transitions to NERIS, building momentum toward nationwide adoption.

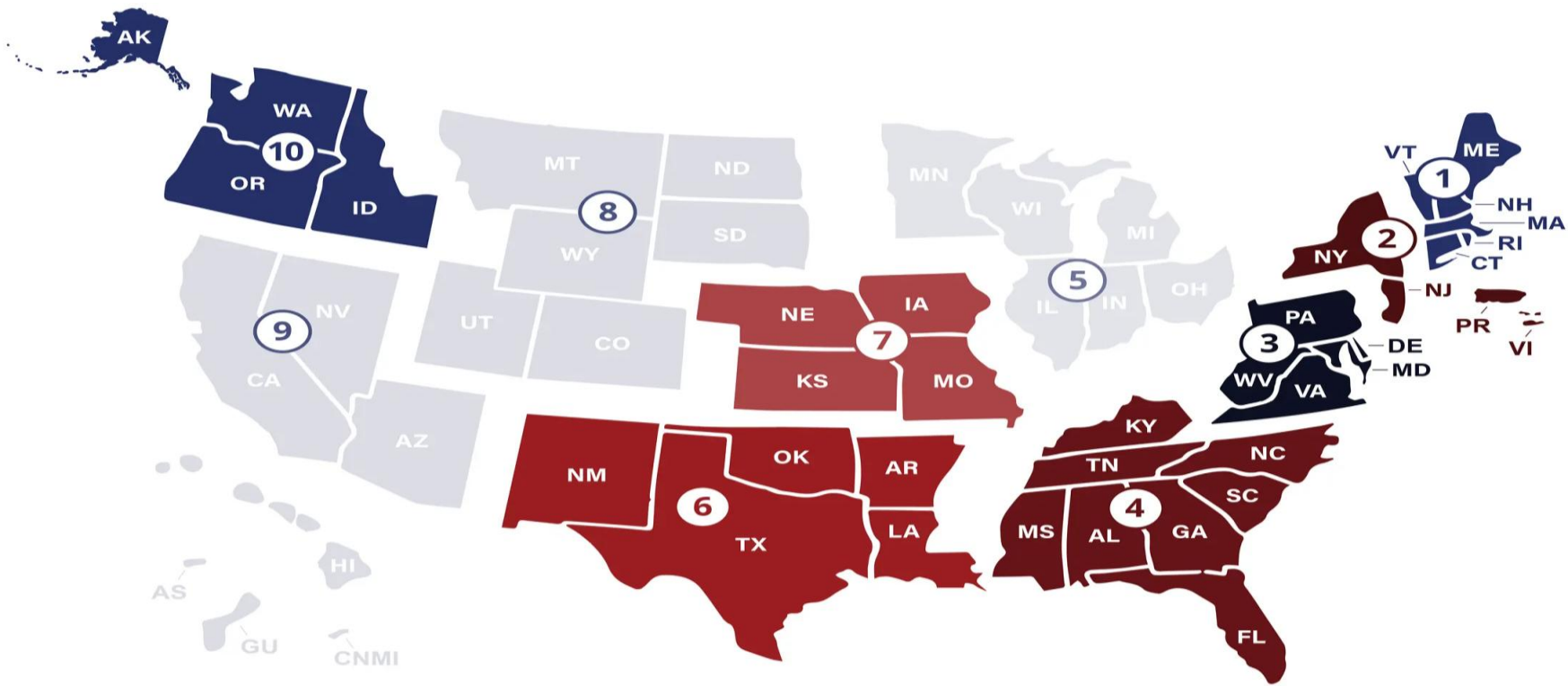
JUL 2025 – Region 6 Onboarding

- Three FEMA regions actively onboarding.
- Over 9,500 departments invited to join NERIS.

NOV 2025 – California Onboarding

California (FEMA Region 9) begins transition.
Benefits from lessons learned in other states.

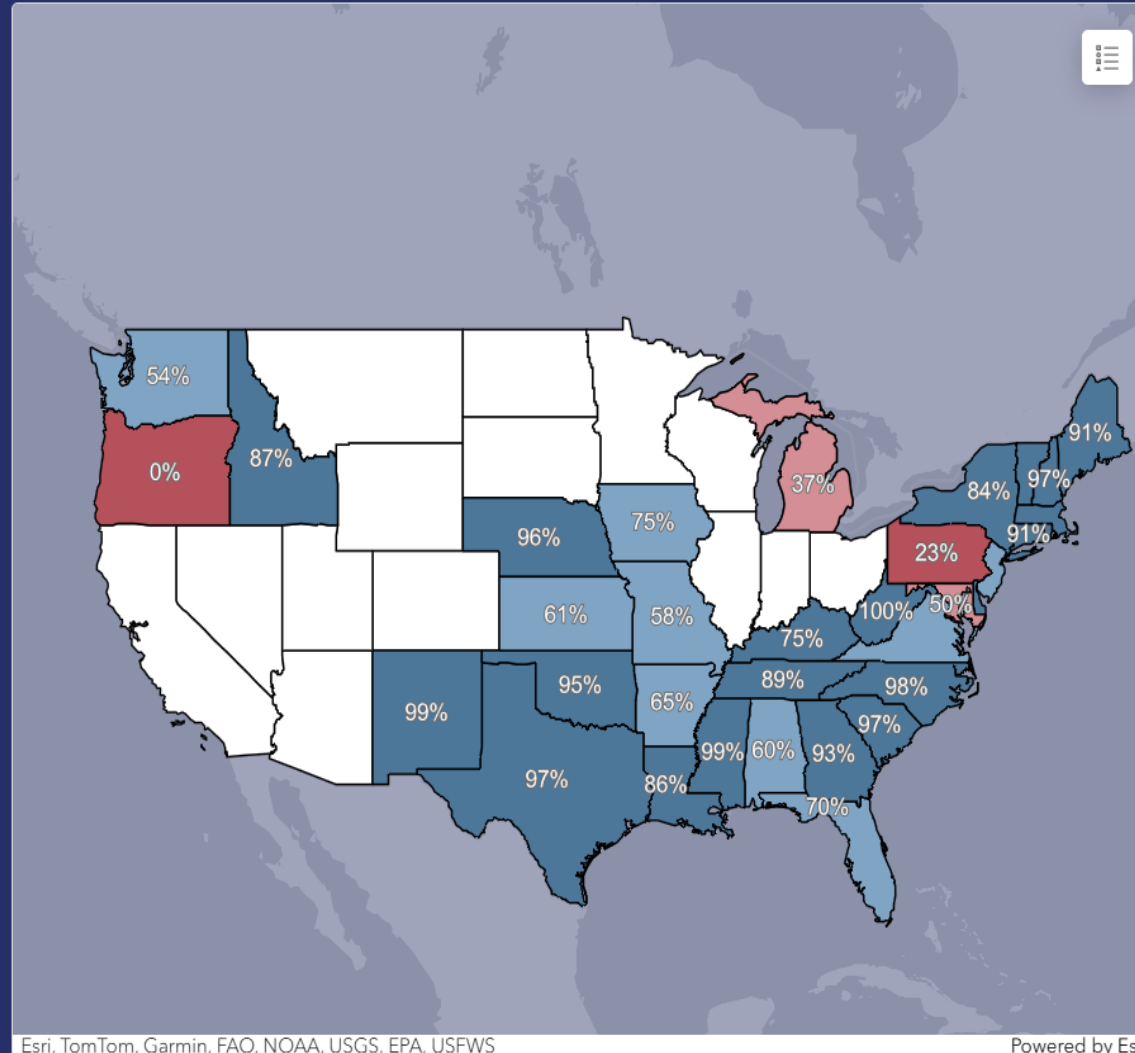

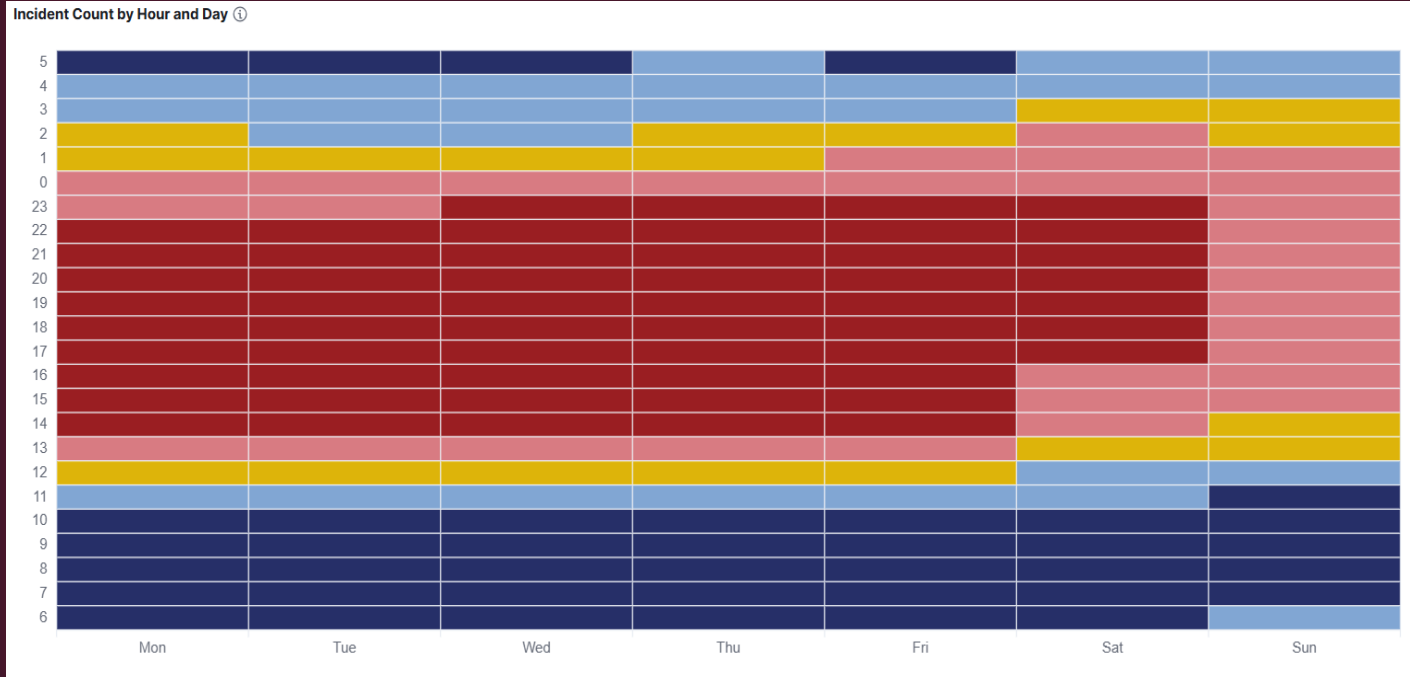

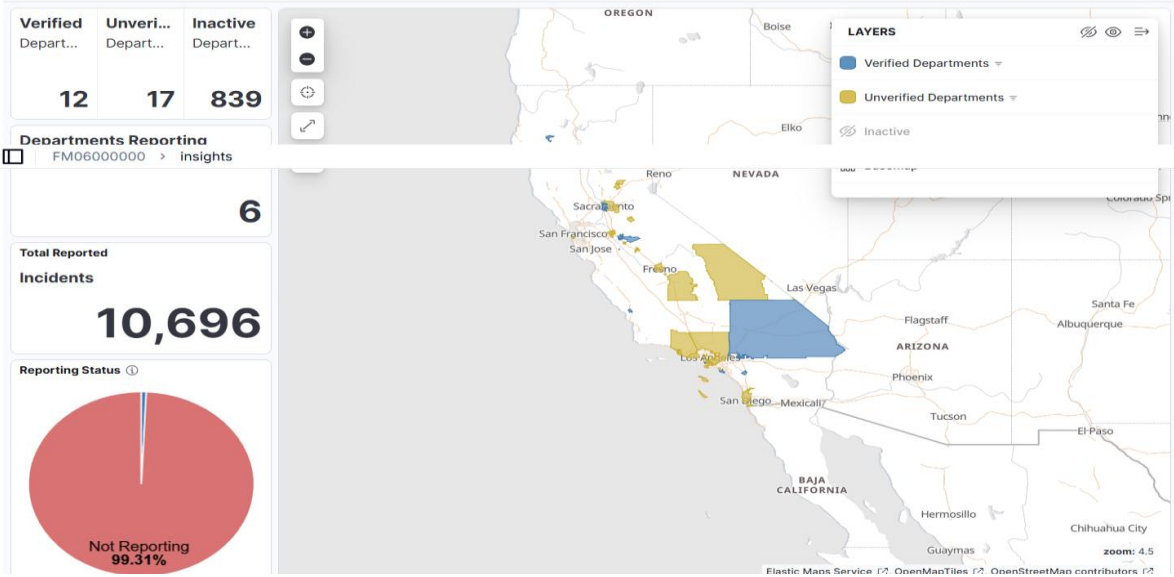

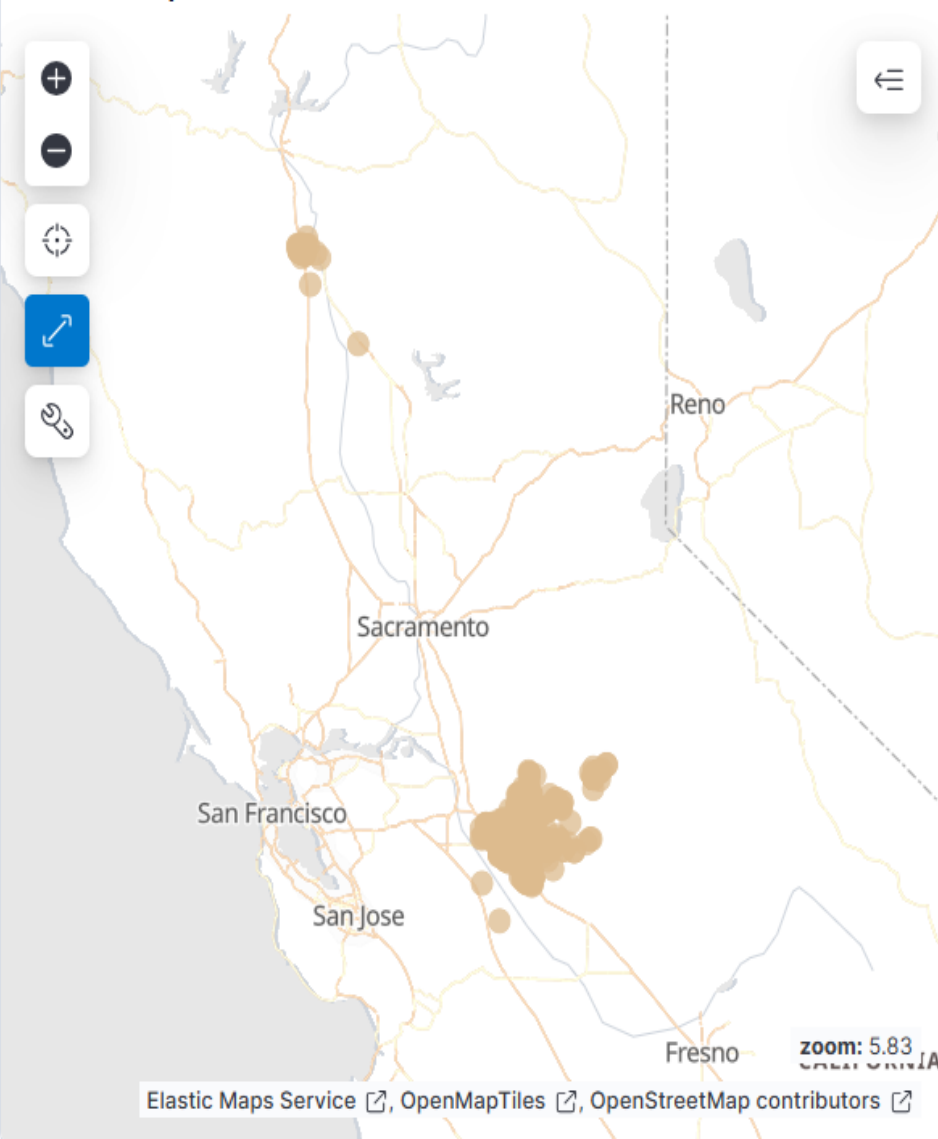

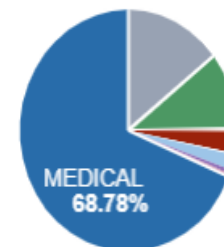

Incidents Map



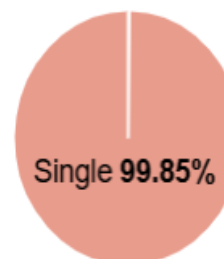
Incidents By Disci...



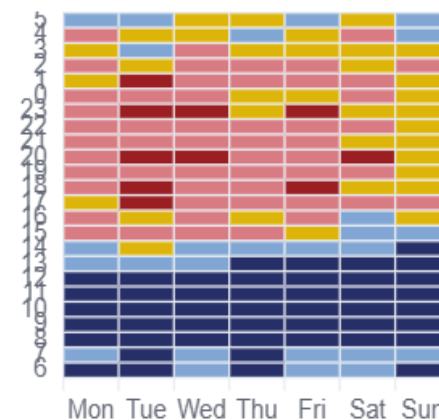
Incident Count Per Week

Two Phases to Success

- ▶ Phase 1: Connect - You will receive two emails: One to Login and One for adding you as a member of your Department.
- ▶ Phase 2: Reporting -
 - ▶ A) If using the NERIS collection app, Fire departments can submit when they are ready, at their scheduled transition. The transition will be a 100% switch. There will be no overlapping in systems.
 - ▶ B) If using a 3rd party RMS - Fire departments can switch after their RMS is ready and they have enabled their RMS software in their department profile. This only occurs at the scheduled transition.





The goal of NERIS is to empower the local fire and emergency services community by equipping them with near real-time information and analytic tools that support data informed decision-making for enhanced preparedness and response to incidents involving all hazards.

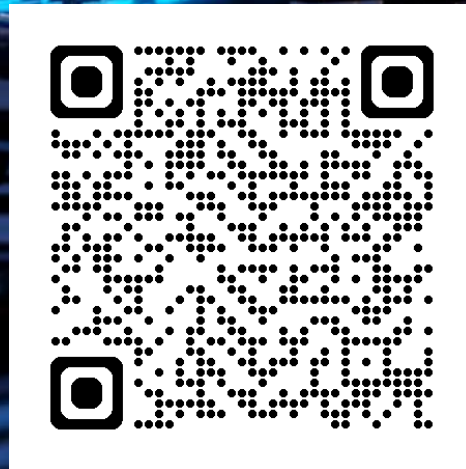
