ESS – Degradation vs. Maximum Aggregate

QUESTION:

Can six Tesla Powerwall batteries (13.5 x 6 = 81kWh) be installed on the exterior wall of an R-3 single-family dwelling?

ANSWER:

No. CFC 1207.11.4 limits the maximum aggregate to 80kWh for exterior walls.

QUESTION:

Does the code provide provisions for degradation such that new equipment may be installed/added to compensate for the projected degradation of an existing system? (ie. 3 new Tesla Powerwall batteries and 3 existing (OLD) Tesla Powerwall aggregated rating is less than 80kWh due to degradation.)

ANSWER:

No. California Fire Code and California Electrical Code does not provide any provisions for degradation.

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
