This fund will be used to deposit fees collected by the State Fire Marshal for licensing and certifications of gasoline vapor control systems, flame retardants, fireworks, pyrotechnic devices, fire extinguishers, automatic extinguishing systems, and building materials listings. All moneys collected will be used to support of the programs administered by the State Fire Marshal.

Major Revenue Source

License and certification fees relating to the regulation of fireworks, pyrotechnic devices, fire protection, and gasoline vapor control systems.

Disposition of Fund (upon abolishment)

Pursuant to Government Code 16346, in the absence of language that identifies a successor fund, any balance remaining in this fund upon abolishment shall be transferred to the General Fund.
