- Our program works with government agencies, non-profit and tribal organizations as well as Fire Safe Councils
- Helping low-income and disadvantaged communities become more economically resilient
- Focus on increasing the protection of people, structures, and communities





### Qualifying Grant Project Activities

#### Hazardous Fuels Reduction

- Vegetation clearance
- Creation or maintenance of fuel breaks
- Community Programs
- Defensible space
- Grazing

#### Wildfire Prevention Planning

- Community Wildfire Protection Plans (CWPP)
- Evacuation route planning
- · Wildfire risk or related mapping

#### Wildfire Prevention Education

- Public education and outreach programs
- Workshops, meetings, materials creation, and other educational activities





#### Selection Criteria



- Grant Project Selection Criteria
  - Wildfire threat
  - Carbon benefits and reducing greenhouse gas emissions
  - Where projects will have greatest benefits
- Projects Ranked by CAL FIRE Units
  - Overall benefits to the Unit coverage area
  - Reduce threat to greatest number of structures and people
  - Benefit to priority populations
    - Low Income
    - Disabled
    - Elderly
  - Fire Risk Reduction Community List
