



Get Ready... Create Defensible Space

Wildfire is Coming. Are You Ready?


Plan. Prepare. Stay Aware.

- Defensible space is the buffer you create between a building on your property and the grass, trees, shrubs, or any wildland area that surround it.
- This space is needed to slow or stop the spread of wildfire and it helps protect your home from catching fire.

Defensible Space Zones

 Understand the zones and their purposes in ensuring you and your community's safety in case of a wildfire related emergency.





Actions to get you started:

- Create and maintain the required 100 feet of Defensible Space.
- Cut or mow annual grass down to a maximum height of four inches.
- Ensure all combustible materials are located
 30 feet away from your home.

- Taking the necessary measures to harden (prepare) your home can help increase its likelihood of survival when wildfire strikes.





 or leave your pets.

Start by getting a campfire permit.


Get your campfire permit and quickly and easily. Campfire permits can also be obtained from any CAL FIRE, US Forest Service, or BLM station or office.

Permit Information

- Campfire Permits are required for open fires, such as campfire, barbecues and portable stoves on federally controlled lands and private lands that are the property of another person.
- Burn Permits are required certain times of the year where residential landscape debris burning is allowed. Homeowners must always check with their local fire station or CAL FIRE station before burning.
- On private lands, written permission from the landowner is also required for campfire use.






Fire Smart Landscaping
