How to Form a FSC

- Appoint at least 5 board members
- Develop a mission statement and community FSC objectives
- Identify first year goals and a timeline
- Map your service area
- Create a logo
- Hold regular community FSC meetings
- Demonstrate commitment and collaboration with partner agencies



Defensible Space Assistance Grant

- Funding to countywide organizations to assist *vulnerable populations* with defensible space treatment on their property.
- Cap and Trade Dollars at Work
- Organizations will develop *innovative projects* that increase the number of properties in compliance with defensible space standards by reducing barriers to participation.

FUNDING AND AWARD PERIOD

- Total available funding: \$4,000,000
- Maximum grant award: \$500,000
- Estimated number of awards: 8
- Award period: September 1, 2023 December 31, 2024
- State-wide eligibility
- Only one organization per county will receive a grant
- Matching funds are not required


