Why do we care about fireworks?



Primary, Fireworks laws and regulations are found in

Health and Safety Code

The Penal Code might be applicable in some cases

Possible local codes

Health and Safety Codes

12505 Defines Dangerous Fireworks

12529 Defines Safe and Sane Fireworks

12676 Unlawful for any Person to sell, transfer, or give any Dangerous Firework


12677 Unlawful to possess dangerous fireworks without a valid permit.

12689 Unlawful to sell or give under 18 years old any dangerous fireworks.

12700 Possession of Illegal fireworks by weight

Classification of Fireworks

- Safe & Sane (12529 H&S)
 Registered with the State Fire Marshal
 - ►Cannot...
 - ► Fly through the air
 - Move across the ground
 - ►Explode
 - State Law only deals with manufacturing and sales

Dangerous Fireworks















What makes a firework item be classified as a Forbidden Explosive?

In California, these items are classified as an <u>explosive</u> since they have more than 50 milligrams or .772 grains of pyrotechnic composition and is in similar design and functions like a firecracker.

Penal Code Violations

18715 Possession of a Destructive Device

18720 Possession of Material to Make Destructive Device

18740 Any person who, ignites, or attempts to ignite a Destructive Device

18755 Any person who willfully and maliciously ignites a Destructive Device with injury or death.
