The Ronny J. Coleman, California Accredited Academy of Excellence will be awarded annually to an Accredited Regional Training Program (ARTP) or Accredited Local Academy (ALA). State Fire Training seeks to honor an academy that *constructively influences* its students through leadership while establishing and promoting *best practices*. They will be recognized for *developing* supportive training and education processes or programs that improve the caliber and quality of the California fire service. This academy will be acknowledged for its ability to *collaborate* successfully within the vocational education community. These outcomes produce fire service members who step up and consistently demonstrate competence, grit, humility, presence, resilience, self-mastery, self-regulation, trust, vigilance, and wellness.

- Completed nominations shall be submitted electronically to chris.fowler@fire.ca.gov by December 31.
- Selection Committee makes the final decision by February 15.
- Presentation at the Annual CAL Chiefs Training Symposium (Fresno, each March)

Criteria

The application will be evaluated and scored on four (4) criteria:

- Constructively Influence The demonstrated ability to lead that impacts the organization, local partners, and/or the California fire and rescue services. (25 percent)
- Best Practices The organization has demonstrated the ability to seek out and adopt or develop best practices. (25 percent)

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- Research and Development Processes or programs that improve the caliber and quality of the California fire and rescue services. (25 percent)
- Replicability and Collaboration The ability of other ARTPs or ALAs to implement a similar practice. (25 percent)
